

Calamondin Orange

Citrus Mitus

General Comments:

This everbearing citrus, also known as “Orangequat”, is usually covered with numerous long-lasting, orange-yellow fruit.

Light

Maximum light; sunny.

Temperature

50-55° F at night, can rise to 60-70°F in daytime on a sunny day or higher with air movement.

Water

Keep moderately dry. Drench thoroughly, then allow to dry between waterings. Watering means soaking the root ball penetratingly if necessary in a bucket, sink or tub of tepid water until air bubbles cease to rise.

Fertilizer

Houseplant type from time to time, with an occasional feeding of Mir-Acid

Soil

Rich garden soil
