

Surfinia

General Information:

Surfinia is an entirely new type of petunia offering long-lasting color. Ever-blooming, heat-loving, long-living and extremely vigorous, Surfinia has a versatility that makes it perfect for baskets, tubs, beds or window boxes. Available in five distinct colors.

Surfinia 'Blue' – Dark purple blooms with a bright yellow center

Surfinia 'Purple' – Bright pink-purple blooms with a dark throat

Surfinia 'White' – Hearty and snowy white

Surfinia 'Blue Vein' – Dark purple veins and center on an almost white flower

Surfinia 'Pink Vein' – Deep pink veins and a dark purple center highlight a pink blush

Surfinia 'Brilliant Mini Pink' – Medium-sized bright pastel pink blossoms

Planting:

Plant Surfinias in baskets, tubs, beds, or window boxes. Surfinias spread or trail, making the ultimate flower cover.

Placement:

Plant Surfinias in full sun areas or in part shade. 6 hours of sun is preferred. Surfinias prefer well-drained organic soils. Avoid wet, soggy, shady areas.

Temperature:

Surfinias love heat and long days. Surfinias tolerate cold temperatures to 28° F, but tender greenhouse grown plants should to be kept above 38° F.

Watering:

Water Surfinias sparingly if planted in the ground. In containers, let Surfinias dry slightly between thorough waterings.

Fertilizer:

Fertilize Surfinias heavily. Use a high nitrogen fertilizer with iron every 4 weeks. In containers, fertilize weekly with a 15-30-15 fertilizer.

Pruning:

Surfinias do not need pruning unless growing in undesirable areas. If trimming is needed, Surfinias respond very well.
