

Swan River Daisy

General Information:

With its compact growth habit and sky-blue daisy flowers, 'Ultra' has become a nationwide hit. Its tenacious flowering habit during hot summer months has made 'Ultra' a favorite with consumers and growers alike. Great used in baskets, pots or the garden. See companion plants below.

Planting:

Grow in full sun/part sun areas. Well drained organic soils are best. An acid pH is preferable. Low-growing, about 6-8 inches with a modest spread of 14-16 inches.

Watering:

If planted in the ground, water sparingly. If in a container, water more frequently, but only when top layer of soil is dry.

Fertilizer:

Fertilize regularly with a good nitrogen fertilizer. Periodically supplement with iron. Fertilize weekly during July & August, use a 15-30-15 fertilizer.

Pruning:

Virtually unnecessary and not recommended.
