

# Calamondin Orange

## General Comments:

This ever-bearing citrus, also known as “Orangequat,” is usually covered with numerous long-lasting, orange-yellow fruit. Their sweet scented flowers fill a sunny room and bloom on and off throughout the year.

## Light

East, West or South exposure. 4 to 6 hours of direct sun or more.

## Temperature

Average home temperature is ok. 60° F at night can rise to 75 - 85° F in daytime on a sunny day (or higher with air movement).

## Water

Keep moderately dry. Drench thoroughly, and then allow plant to dry between waterings. Watering means soaking the root ball, penetratingly if necessary, in a bucket, sink or tub of tepid water until air bubbles cease to rise.

## Fertilizer

Houseplant fertilizer, Mir-Acid 30-10-10 at half strength every 6 weeks.

## Soil

Top quality potting soil.
